Supplementary Regulations

1) Announcement

Hants & Berks Motor Club Ltd will organise a Certificate of Exemption Touring Assembly on Sunday 16th June 2024. The event will start from Reading West (westbound) Motorway Services RG30 3UQ between J 11 and J 12 (Slip road off M4 at OS Map Ref. 175/676697).

2) Jurisdiction

This event will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA and these Supplementary Regulations.

3) Permits

Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption Permit number 135399 has been issued.

4) Eligibility

The event is open to all fully paid-up members of Hants & Berks Motor Club Ltd and other invited participants. Both Classic and Modern cars are welcome.

5) Event start

The event will start at 9.30 a.m. Participating cars will leave the start at one-minute intervals. Any competitor not signed on by 10.15 a.m. may be excluded.

6) Description of Event

The event consists of a non-competitive Scenic Road Tour following predominantly country roads and finishing at the 'Hollycombe Steam in the Country Museum', near Liphook, Hampshire GU30 7LP (Entrance OS Map Ref. 186/850297½). The route is approximately 55 miles long. The road route will be detailed in a 'Route Book' which will be posted to entrants a few days before the event. Ordnance Survey Maps Nos 174, 175, 185 and 186 were used in the planning of this event but are not necessary. A general road atlas may help if you become 'lost' during the event.

7) Identification

Identification numbers for cars will be issued by the organisers.

8) Entries

The maximum entry for the meeting is 50. Entries will be accepted on a first received first served basis. The first 40 entries received will receive a Monte Carlo Style Rally Plate with their Route Book. The organisers reserve the right to cancel the event if fewer than 20 entries are received.

9) Entry List
